NMIOTC announces the NMIOTC Annual Conference which will take place in NMIOTC premises (Souda Bay - Crete) from 18th to 20th June 2013. Draft agenda as per Annex A.

2. **Theme**

"Future Security at Sea - MIO Roles"

3. Aim

The upcoming 2013 NMIOTC Annual Conference will provide new opportunities for discussion and path forward proposals in dealing with future maritime security threats and linkages with Maritime Interdiction Operations, investigating interdependencies and influences. Based on the results, specific followup actions and areas will be identified, which would lead to implementation of new domains in consideration of future training and engagement via NMIOTC.

4. **Conference Pillars**

Conference will be focused but not limited to the following pillars:

a. Border Security

- (i) Identity Operations (Biometrics)
- (ii) Human Trafficking
- (iii) Illegal Immigration
- (iv)Trafficking illicit goods

b. Energy Security

- (i) Critical Infrastructure Protection
- (ii) Maritime Piracy (HOA & West Africa)
- (iii) Operational Costs Energy consideration

c. MIO in Strategic Chokepoints

- (i) WMD Counter Proliferation
- (ii) Maritime Terrorism / Piracy

d. Civil Military Cooperation

- (i) Civil Military Cooperation in Organized crime (UN, EU, INTERPOL etc)
- (ii) Intelligence/Information Sharing (NATO, EU, IMO, UNODC etc)
- (iii) Information Sharing with Non-NATO Entities

5. Schedule

The Conference will be conducted over three days, from Tuesday 18th to Thursday 20th of June 2013. It is advised to use Monday 17th (or earlier) and Friday 21st June 2013 (or later) as travel days.

A detailed Agenda, as well as Spouses Program will be issued by 1st of June 2013.

6. Participants

Registration is open to all interested participants such as officers and civilians coming from NATO and EU entities, NATO and EU countries and Partner Nations representing their navy, coast guard or port police services, law enforcement experts, officials from other relevant organizations and third party countries. Speakers from military organizations and academia will present their views on the topic, while the audience will be comprised of military and civilian personnel involved or interested in maritime security. Please feel free to forward this invitation to persons that you deem relevant and interested to attend.

7. Attire

The attire for the Conference will be coat & tie for civilians, while service uniform for the military personnel.

8. Registration

Participants are requested to submit a registration application, no later than 5th of June 2013, following the instructions contained on the website, www.nmiotc.gr

9. Lodging and Transportation

Although attendees are responsible for the arrangement of their own accommodation, NMIOTC can provide guidance if requested. Transportation to / from the NMIOTC installations and specified pick-up points in the city of Chania will be provided.

10. Classification

Unclassified, releasable to internet.

11. Conference fee

The Conference fee is 100 € for attendees, while an additional fee of 50 € for spouses will be required, should they want to participate in the Spouses Program. Fee should be paid in cash on the first day of the event and an official receipt will be provided.

Excursion to Knossos (Metropolis of the Minoan Civilization funded about 1900 BC) is optional and there will be an additional cost of 20€ in case of participation.

12. Visa Requirements

Participants or their sending authorities are responsible for visa arrangements for their personnel. It is advised that participants contact their national embassies/consulates in Greece or the Greek Military Attachés at the Greek Embassies in their respective capitals for relevant information.


