NMIOTC Course 12000 “C-IED in Maritime Interdiction Operations”

Resident Course “12000” was conducted at NMIOTC premises from 12 to 16 of October 2020. This “NATO Approved” Course fills an operational gap in capability and contributes to counter-threat operations conducted by Boarding Teams when searching for securing and exploiting evidence, which are fundamental to the counter-threat process.

The aim was to educate and train international Boarding Team personnel in NATO TTPs (Tactics, Technics and Procedures) to undertake expedient weapons intelligence tasks on board vessels and other maritime infrastructure in support of C-IED operations.

In total, twelve (12) trainees from three (3) countries (Greece, Qatar and United Arab Emirates) attended the course. Training was delivered with the participation of Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) from the United Kingdom, in cooperation with NMIOTC Sea Trainers.
