1. NMIOTC is pleased to invite NATO and partner nations to participate in this event, which will take place at the Centre's premises in Souda Bay, Chania, Greece, from 30 May to 03 June 2022.
2. The aim of the course is to deliver the appropriate knowledge and practical skills to members of the Security and Recovery teams of a naval unit in order to prepare them to fulfil their tasks related to Migration Related Incidents at Sea. The desired outcome is to prepare the participants to execute specific tasks related to dealing with migrants at sea
3. The target audience is Officers ranging from OF-1 to OF-3 and Petty Officers (CPO, PO) / Enlisted personnel from **Naval Units**. Military or civilian personnel from other agencies and organizations tasked to participate in support of maritime interdiction operations and migration related operations are also eligible to participate.
4. The course will be conducted in English. Translation to/from other languages will not be provided. The following proficiency standards in English are required to attend: Listening- - Functional (2), Speaking- Functional (2), Reading- Functional (2), Writing- Survival (1) (STANAG 6001).
5. The course is marked as “**NATO Unclassified** / Releasable to: PFP (except Russia), MD, ICI, PatG”. Non-NATO Entities are eligible for participation upon NAC approval. Registration should be made on NMIOTC's official web site www.nmiotc.nato.int. NMIOTC applies security arrangements and regulations according to NATO standards.

6. The curriculum of Course 15000 is as stated below:

- a. Module 15010 – Migration overview
- b. Module 15020 – Legal Aspects in Migration Related Operations
- c. Module 15030 – Operational phases and Unit's organizations
- d. Module 15040 – Case Studies and Lessons Learned during Migration Related Operations
- e. Module 15050 – Security Procedures
- f. Module 15060 – Recovery of persons at sea and post recovery procedures
- g. Module 15070 – Crowd Control
- h. Module 15080 – Final Tactical Exercise (FTX)

NOTE: A detailed agenda will be included in the Joining Instructions letter which will be released in due course

7. The attendees must attend at least 85% of the module classes of the course. The achievement of POs / ELOs will be assessed during a Final Tactical Exercise (FTX) upon conclusion of the course.

8. The cost for the course is **450 €** per person. Comprehensive administrative instructions can be found in Enclosure 1.

9. The course will start on **Monday, 30 May 2022 and will end on Friday, 03 Jun 2022**, with a daily training period from 08:30 to 14:30. Comprehensive administrative instructions are provided in Enclosure 1.

10. For organizational purposes, candidates are kindly requested to return their application forms to NMIOTC **no later than (NLT) Friday 22nd April 2022**. Candidates from Non-NATO Entities must submit their applications **NLT Friday 28th January 2022**, so that adequate time is provided for NATO approval procedures. 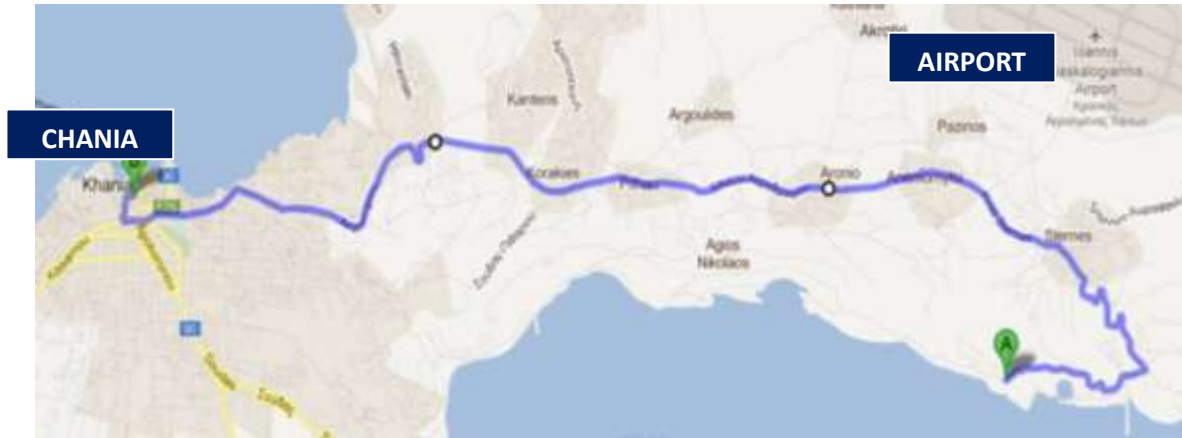

ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Location: NMIOTC is located on the Akrotiri peninsula near the city of Chania in the north-western part of Crete. The destination airport is Chania International Airport (“Ioannis Daskalogiannis” Airport) (airport code: CHQ). Distance from the city of Chania to NMIOTC is 20 km and from the airport to NMIOTC is 9 km. The following map provides orientation and general driving directions from the city of Chania to NMIOTC.



2. Registration: You are kindly requested to submit your Application through NMIOTC official web site www.nmiotc.nato.int within the given deadlines. Applications submitted after the specified deadlines may not be accepted. All applicants will receive an instant confirmation message. However the final confirmation will be provided after the process and acceptance of the application. It is advised not to proceed to travel arrangements before the final confirmation.

3. Visa Requirement: Participants or their national authorities are responsible for visa arrangements. Participants are advised to contact the proper diplomatic agencies for up to date information, well in advance. It is the individual’s responsibility to apply for and obtain their visa and to have the proper travel and medical documentation. Hellenic Ministry of Foreign Affairs website (www.mfa.gr) provides relevant visa information requirements. NMIOTC will provide a Visa Support Letter, if requested.

4. Tuition Fee:

a. The cost for the Course is **450 €** per person. The fee includes daily transportation from Chania city center to NMIOTC and vice versa during the course days.

b. Full payment in cash or by credit card will be made to NMIOTC’s Financial Officer upon arrival at NMIOTC during the in-processing procedure. Attendees may also pay by bank deposit to NMIOTC’s bank account with the following data:

Note: A direct line for card payment can be sent upon request. Bank deposit must be executed **no later than 3 working days** prior to the start of the event. The relevant paperwork must be forwarded to the Budget & Finance officer's e-mail: kladosa@nmiotc.nato.int. NMIOTC will cover only the expenses that the National Bank of Greece may charge for transactions and not any potential charges of other third party banks that may be used as facilitators.

5. Dress Code: Participants are strongly recommended to wear Daily Service/ Battle Dress Uniforms or National Equivalent for the whole training as well as for the Graduation Ceremony.

6. Meals: A small canteen is available within the NMIOTC main building that will provide snacks for a nominal cost. Participants who would like to have lunch while at NMIOTC must make their own arrangements as NMIOTC does not provide this service.

7. Accommodation: Participants are responsible to arrange their own accommodation as there is no accommodation facilities on the Centre's premises. NMIOTC can provide guidance / assistance, if requested. Hotels near Chania city center are highly recommended for transportation purposes. 8. Arrival and Departure: Participants should plan to fly to Chania International airport (airport code: CHQ) and are responsible for their own transportation from / to the Airport during arrival / departure. Public transportation from Chania Airport to the city center is available as follows:

9. Transportation: Transportation will be provided on a daily basis from Chania city centre pick-up points (Akali, Samaria, Kydon, Kriti and Royal Sun at Acrotiriou st.) to NMIOTC during the course.

10. Medical service: Trainees are required to have a valid health insurance according to their respective national standards. Trainees from the EU Member States are required to possess a valid European Health Insurance Card. NMIOTC ensures first aid during training, providing emergency transportation to the Naval Hospital of Crete when needed. The Naval Hospital of Crete can provide diagnosis, first aid and treatment. The military doctors may arrange further diagnosis or specialist treatment with the Prefectural Hospital of Chania if required. NMIOTC is not covering trainees' expenses for medical treatments and the settlement of medical bills is a patient/national responsibility.

11. COVID 19 awareness: Please take under consideration that due to the current COVID-19 situation and the undertaken preventive and protective measures, the conduct of the course is considered, feasible. Furthermore NMIOTC is ready to welcome participants to NMIOTC's events according to the new travel rules as described in details in the governmental site <https://travel.gov.gr/#/> (protocol for arrivals in Greece) as well as the latest instructions uploaded to the NMIOTC site <https://nmiotc.nato.int/general-information-on-coronavirus-covid-19/> which are to be followed at its latest update.

Note: It is advised the participants to take into account any further travel restrictions and rules from intermediate countries that they will travel through.

12. Security: NMIOTC adheres to NATO security standards. There is a strict access control procedure for entrance into the Marathi main gate and NMIOTC main building. You will be required to provide your passport or your national identification during in-processing and whenever you enter the premises.
