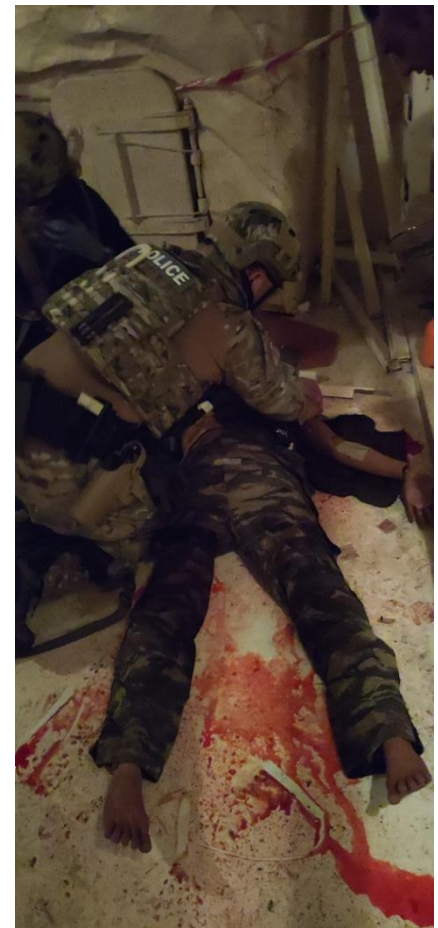
**Course 26000**  
**“Tactical Combat Casualty Care/ Combat Lifesaver**  
**in Maritime Operations”**

Resident Course 26000 “Tactical Combat Casualty Care/ Combat Lifesaver in Maritime Operations” was conducted from 28<sup>th</sup> of February to 04<sup>th</sup> of March 2022 at NMIOTC premises.

Course objective was to provide knowledge and practical skills to first responders in order to improve survivability on the battlefield by delivering necessary pre hospital care with limited equipment and in confined spaces, based on the newest Co - TCCC Guidelines.

Training was delivered by six (6) certified instructors from Greece and USA, specialized in combat medics and in absolute coherence with NAEMT’s policy and regulations.

Ten (10) trainees from five (5) nations attended the course (Belgium, Germany, Greece Netherlands and Portugal).
