Course 14000 **“Maritime Improvised Explosive Device Disposal (M-IEDD)”**

Resident Course 14000 “Maritime Improvised Explosive Device Disposal (M-IEDD)” was conducted from 04 to 08 April 2022 at NMIOTC premises.

Course objective was to educate and train EOD personnel to competently undertake IEDD Operations on-board vessels and other Maritime Infrastructure in support of C-IED and related operations. The training covered the subject concepts, philosophy, principles, equipment, ship insertion and Maritime focused IEDD methodologies, as well as best practices in the Maritime environment.

Twenty (20) trainees from eight (8) nations attended the course (Austria, Bahrain, Finland, Greece, Latvia, Poland, Slovenia and Spain).

Subject Matter Experts from respected authorities such as Greek Army and Police provided support to the course as Augmenters, in addition to the Centre’s Instructors and Lecturers.
