Maritime Border Security Workshop under Counter Terrorism Perspective

From 14 to 16 of May 2023 NMIOTC, the Jordanian Armed forces (JAF) and the Royal Jordanian Navy (RJN) co-organized a workshop in Aqaba on Maritime Border Security under the Counter Terrorism perspective. The initiative, led by NATO HQ – Emerging Security Challenges Division and Operations Division, brought together International Organizations and National experts in the field of Maritime Border Security, in order to assist the host nation to further tackle major risks and challenges by presenting best practices and through scenarios' based discussions among the stakeholders.
