## **Course 12000 “C-IED in Maritime Interdiction Operations”**

From 4<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> of March 2024, the Resident Course 12000 “C-IED in Maritime Interdiction Operations” was conducted at NMIOTC premises. This “NATO Approved” Course fills an operational gap in capability and contributes to operations conducted by Boarding Teams when searching and exploiting evidence, which are fundamental to the C-IED process.

The aim was to train international Boarding Team personnel in NATO TTPs (Tactics, Technics and Procedures) to undertake expedient weapons intelligence tasks on board vessels and other Maritime infrastructure in support of C-IED operations.

In total, eighteen (18) trainees from nine (9) countries (Azerbaijan, Belgium, Georgia, Germany, Greece, Italy, Morocco, Poland and Ukraine) attended the course. The Training was delivered with the participation of Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) from the FBI, Hungarian Non Commissioned Officer Academy and the Hellenic Police in cooperation with NMIOTC Sea Trainers.
