## Cyber Security Training for Purple Teams “Guardian Purple 2024”



From 13<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> of May 2024, the 1<sup>st</sup> – pilot iteration of Cyber Defence Training for Purple Teams (PTs) “**Guardian Purple 2024**” (#GP24), organized by NMIOTC with support from SHAPE J6, took place in virtual training format. GP24 was attended by 80 cyber security professionals from 7 Allied Nations’ Cyber Defence Purple Teams (PTs), coming from Bulgaria, Denmark, Greece, Italy, Latvia Romania and Poland.

The aim of the training was to equip participants from NATO PTs with a thorough understanding of contemporary cyber-attack methods and the practical skills necessary to proactively prevent, detect, and respond to these threats.

Participants were trained, in a highly interactive manner, on how verify their organization cyber-attack surface and vulnerabilities, verify the ability of adversaries to take advantage of those vulnerabilities, to recognize and respond to a cyber-attack. They will receive recommendations on responses and advice on how to evaluate strategies, tools, procedures, and how to effectively collaborate with other PT members.
