Course objective was to deliver the appropriate knowledge to the Command Teams of naval units in order to prepare them to fulfil the unit’s specific tasks related to operations to assist law enforcement agencies with the refugee and migrant crisis at sea.

In total, twelve (12) trainees coming from six (6) countries (Belgium, Greece, Ireland, Italy Kuwait and Poland) attended the course.

Subject Matter Experts from respected authorities such as Hellenic Coastguard and Crete Naval Hospital provided support to the course as Augmenters, in addition to the Centre’s Instructors and Lecturers.
