Course 31000 “Harbour Protection and its relation to MIO”

From 7th to 11th of October 2024, the pilot iteration of the Course 31000 “Harbour Protection and its relation to MIO”, with support from Bundeswehr Technical Center for Ships and Naval Weapons, Maritime Technology and Research (WTD-71) and NATO CoE CSW, was conducted at the NMIOTC premises.

The aim of the course is to provide NATO and national military personnel with extensive knowledge and skills to effectively conduct Harbour Protection (HP) duties and functions to improve NATO’s HP performance by exploiting the full potential of HP capabilities. The Course also intends to educate and train students in NATO practices and procedures regarding operational and tactical dimensions of planning and conducting a HP Operation (HPO).

In total, nine (9) trainees from seven (7) NATO Nations (Germany, Estonia, Greece, Italy, Hungary, Latvia and Lithuania), including officers from Allied Maritime Command (NATO MARCOM) and NATO MILENG CoE, attended the Course.
