NMIOTC instructor in SOFCOM Medical Instructor Development Course

From 16th to 27th September 2024, NMIOTC contributed with one (1) Subject Matter Expert as Instructor to the SOF “Medical Instructor Development and Tactical Combat Casualty Care Instructor Course”, led by the Allied Special Operations Forces Command (SOFCOM) Medical Mobile Training Team, at the Specialized Training Complex Tsrancha, Bulgaria.

The course aims to educate students on the importance of requirements analysis for SOF medical training, instructional design, skill acquisition in non-permissive environments, scenario based training and the wide range of debriefing that SOF MED personnel often have to undertake.

NMIOTC has been the first NATO Education and Training Facility (NETF) to receive National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) certification. Our Centre is an Authorized NAEMT Training Centre eligible to provide Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC) Courses.

In November, NMIOTC is running the Course 21000 “Medical Combat Care In Maritime Operations”, and, later that month, the Course 26000 “Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC)/Combat Lifesaver (CLS) in Maritime Operations”.
