Activation of NMIOTC Training Platform HS LYKOUDIS

NATO Maritime Interdiction Operational Training Centre proudly announces the activation of its latest training platform HS LYKOUDIS, with the invaluable support of the Hellenic Navy General Staff and the Souda Naval Base. Along with two (2) new classrooms (isoboxes) in the adjacent training area, with a capacity of 18 persons each, the new platform will enhance NMIOTC's capabilities to deliver cutting-edge training for maritime interdiction, in support of global security efforts.

HS LYKOUDIS is designed to replicate realistic maritime scenarios, allowing NMIOTC to conduct a wide range of exercises from counter-piracy and counter-terrorism to the interception of illicit trafficking. HS LYKOUDIS offers a unique, adaptable environment for NATO personnel and partners to hone essential skills under realistic, mission-focused conditions.

The activation of HS LYKOUDIS as a secondary platform, strengthens NMIOTC's role in the Alliance's strategic vision for maritime security, in the context of contemporary maritime interdiction. NMIOTC remains steadfast in its mission to train, educate, and prepare military forces for complex, multi-faceted operations that safeguard the seas.
