## <u>Course 26000 "Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC)/</u> <u>Combat Lifesaver (CLS) in Maritime Operations"</u>


From 25<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> of November 2024, the Resident Course 26000 "Tactical Combat Casualty Care / Combat Lifesaver in Maritime Operations" was successfully conducted at the Centre's premises.

The course aims to provide to all combatants and first responders (SOF and conventional personnel) involved in Maritime Operations basic knowledge and skills in delivering necessary pre hospital care with limited equipment and in confined spaces. Furthermore, critical and essential skills is taught so as the first responders be able to assist medical personnel to provide more complicated medical assistance and deal effectively with a mass casualty situation.

NMIOTC has been the first NATO Education and Training Facility (NETF) to receive National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) certification. Our Centre is an Authorized NAEMT Training Centre eligible to provide TCCC Courses.

Sixteen (16) participants from six (6) Countries (Bahrain, Germany, Greece, Malta, Lithuania and USA) attended the course. Training was delivered by Subject Matter Experts, certified as NAEMT instructors, and augmenters specialized in stress management, telemedicine, and prolonged field care. In total, thirteen (13) trainers from NMIOTC, the Hellenic Police, the Hellenic Coast Guard and NSA Souda Bay, supported the course as instructors.
