B. NPOW 2015

1. NMIOTC is organizing its 6th Annual Conference which will take place at NMIOTC premises in Marathi-Souda Bay, Chania-Greece, from 2nd to 4th of June 2015. Joining Instructions to participants are hereby provided.

2. Arrival and Departure:

It is strongly recommended that the arrival is planned no later than Monday, 1st of June 2015 and departure no earlier than 16:00 on Thursday, 4th of June 2015. Participants should plan to fly to Chania International Airport (airport code: CHQ).

3. Transportation

- a. Participants are responsible for their own transportation from/to the Airport during arrival and departure day. NMIOTC will provide transportation only from/to specific pick-up points. Transportation from these points in Chania city center to NMIOTC's premises and vice-versa, (see detailed map as per Enclosure «4»), will be provided by NMIOTC on a daily basis, during the conference. Pick-up Points are as follows:
 - (1) Old Market (Chania): 1st pick-up point, at 07:30.
- (2) 1866 Square (Chania): 2nd pick-up point at 07:40 (bus will stop across SAMARIA hotel).
- (3) Royal Sun hotel: 3rd pick-up point, at 07:50 (bus will stop at Akrotiriou Street). Although the hotel is located within walking distance from NMIOTC

bus route (see the map below), transportation from the hotel to the pick up point and vice versa will be provided by the hotel.

- b. Transportation from Chania Airport to Chania city centre is available as follows:
- (1) By Bus: The bus stop is outside the terminal and the cost is 2,30 Euros. For further information and detailed timetables check http://www.bus-service-crete-ktel.com/timetabledet.php?line=32&lg=2.
- (2) By taxi from the airport directly to Chania city center, 24 hours/day, 25, 00 Euros (approx).
- (3) Additionally there are several car rental agencies at the airport. Participants who will rent their own vehicles should inform NMIOTC's Admin Officer (cc'd the OPR) or NMIOTC Duty Officer (+30 6947 159634) about the type and the plates number of the rental car/mini bus, in order to issue security clearance to enter the main gate of Marathi.
- c. Participants with the availability of rental cars/mini bus are advised to be at NMIOTC premises at 08:15, each conference day.

Accommodation

There are no accommodation facilities at NMIOTC. Participants are responsible to make their own arrangements. Hotels near Chania city centre are highly recommended for transportation purposes. A list of hotels that offer special prices for "NMIOTC guests" in the vicinity can be found in Enclosure «1». For your own orientation the following area map is provided.



5. **Conference Schedule:** The conference schedule is according to the agenda reported in Enclosure «2».

- 6. **Dress Code:** Jacket and tie for civilians and summer Service Uniform for the militaries.
- 7. **Visa Requirements:** Participants or their authorities are responsible for visa arrangements. Participants are advised to contact in advance proper diplomatic agencies, for accurate information. It is an individual's responsibility to apply and obtain his/her Visa and to have updated travel (including medical) documentation.
- 8. **Security Instructions:** The conference has no classification. However, NMIOTC applies security issues according to NATO standards.
- 9. **Badging process:** A welcome package that includes security badge and all the nessecary information will be delivered to the participants who are accommodated to the recommended hotels upon their arrival. Else, the welcome package will be provided at the NMIOTC main entrance. There is a strict access control to enter Marathi main gate and NMIOTC main building. You will be required to carry your security badge along with your passport or your national identification card during check in and throught your presence to NMIOTC.

10. Conference Fee:

- a. The Conference fee is one hundred and thirty five Euros (135 €) per person and includes daily transportation from Chania city center to NMIOTC and vice versa during working days, the daily lunches as well as participation to social events. For the convenience of the participants who are going to attend part of the event the conference fee for each day is breaking down as follow:
 - (1). 1st day 60,00€
 - (2). 2nd day 40.00€
 - (3). 3rd day 35€
- b. Participants' full payment for fees will be paid either to NMIOTC's Financial Officer the first day of the course <u>in_cash</u>, or <u>by_bank_deposit</u> to NMIOTC bank account with the following data:

Note: Bank deposit has to be completed no later than Friday 29 May 2015. The relevant document with proper justification has to be e-mailed to Budget and Finance Officer at sartzetakiv@nmiotc.nato.int. NMIOTC will cover only the expenses that National Bank of Greece may charge for the transactions and not the potential charges of the other banks that may finally intervene.

- 11. **Medical service:** First aid and emergency medical support is offered by NMIOTC paramedic and local Naval Hospital. However, for all other situations, medical expenses must be paid by the individuals **or** their insurance agencies. All participants are strongly advised to have appropriate medical insurance.
- 12. **Social events:** Social events for the participants as well as for their spouses are as Enclosure «3».






